RECOMMENDED PROGRAM

Day 01 **BANGKOK – SIEM REAP** **(-/L/D)**

a.m. Bangkok – Siem Reap by **PG 930** (0800-0900)
 Arrive at Siem Reap International airport and transfer to the hotel (*rooms may not ready until the afternoon*)
 Visit the ancient capital of **Angkor Thom** (12th century).
 See the **South Gate** with its huge statues depicting the churning of the ocean of milk, **Bayon Temple** (unique for its 54 towers decorated with over 200 smiling faces of Avolokitesvara), the **Royal Enclosure**, **Phimeanakas**, **the Elephants Terrace** and the **Terrace of the Leper King**



p.m. Lunch at hotel
 Visit the most famous of all the temples on the plain of Angkor: **Angkor Wat**.
 The temple complex covers 81 hectares and is comparable in size to the Imperial Palace in Beijing. Its distinctive five towers are emblazoned on the Cambodian flag and the 12th century masterpiece is considered by art historians to be the prime example of classical Khmer art and architecture. Angkor Wat's five towers symbolize Meru's five peaks - the enclosed wall represents the mountains at the edge of the world and the surrounding moat, the ocean beyond. Sunset at Angkor Wat or from **Phnom Bakheng**, one of the two hills dominating the plain of Angkor, from where you will have a spectacular view of the Western Baray (ancient reservoir) and Angkor Wat
 Dinner at local restaurant for Option I (Angkor Century Hotel)
 Compulsory dinner at hotel for Option II (Sofitel Royal Angkor Hotel) & III (Grand Hotel D' Angkor)

RECOMMENDED PROGRAM – CONTINUED

Day 02 SIEM REAP (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel

a.m. Continue your temple tour. Visit the unique brick sculptures of **Prasat Kravan**, the mountain-temple of **Pre Rup, Mebon Oriental, Ta Som, Neak Pean**, a fountain (built in the middle of a pool and representing the paradisiacal Himalayan mountain-lake). Then visit **Preah Khan** temple. Built by the King Jayavarman VII, Preah Khan is, like Ta Prohm, a place of towered enclosures and shoulders-hanging corridors. Unlike Ta Prohm, however, Preah Khan is in a reasonable state of preservation and ongoing restoration efforts should maintain and even improve this situation. Lunch at hotel

p.m. Visit **Srah Srang**, "The Royal Baths" which was once used for ritual bathing. Continue your temple tour with stops at **Takeo, Thommanon, Chau Say Tevoda** and **Ta Prohm**. One of the area's most beautiful temples, Ta Prohm has been relatively untouched since it was discovered and retains much of its mystery. Its appeal lies in the fact that, unlike the other monuments of Angkor, it has been left to be swallowed by the jungle, and looks very much the ways most of the monuments of Angkor appeared when European explorer first stumbled upon them



Dinner at local restaurant for Option I (Angkor Century Hotel)
Compulsory dinner at hotel for Option II (Sofitel Royal Angkor Hotel) & III (Grand Hotel D' Angkor)

Day 03 SIEM REAP – BANGKOK (B/L/-)

Breakfast at hotel

a.m. Visit the floating village of **Chong Khneas**, located 10 kilometers south of Siem Reap. Take a traditional wooden boat for a ride on the **Tonle Sap Lake**, the "Great Lake" of Cambodia, one of the largest in Asia



Lunch at hotel

p.m. Visit "**Les Artisans d'Angkor - Chantiers Ecoles**" of Siem Reap and time at leisure at the local market (if time permits)

Transfer to → Siem Reap International airport for departure flight to Bangkok by **PG 937** (1900-2000) or **PG 943** (1930-2030) or **PG 947** (2020-2120)
